Tom's approach is clear, practical, and grounded in evidence-based movement, helping students truly understand why they're teaching what they're teaching.

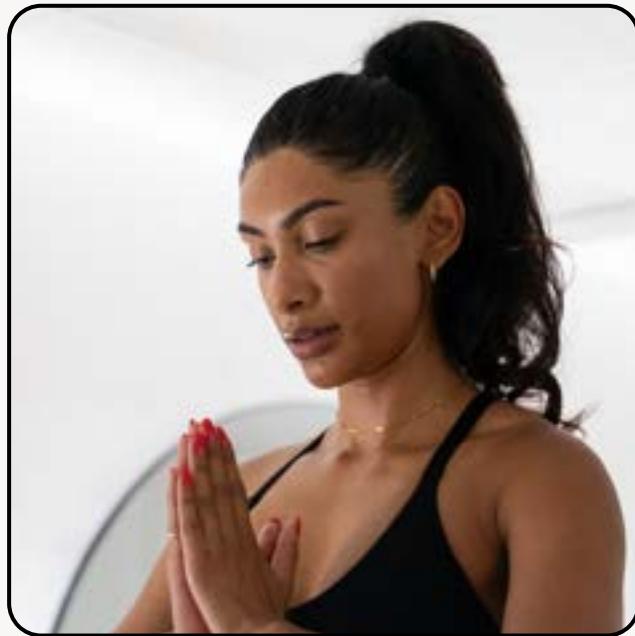

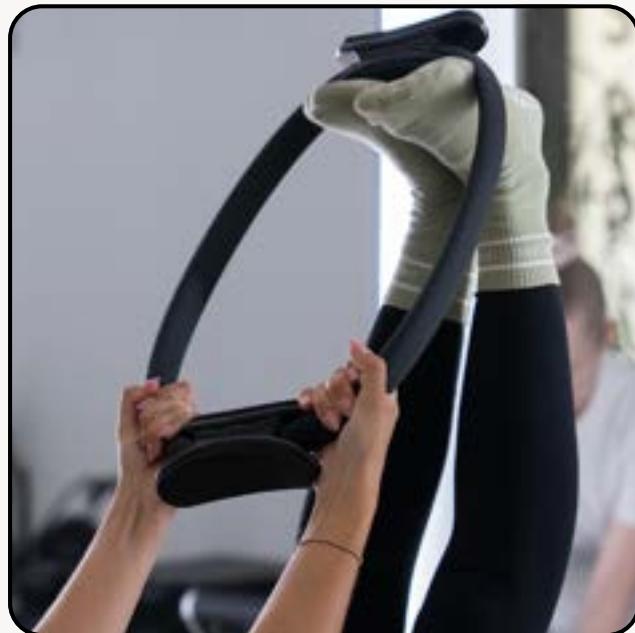

When are the upcoming course dates?

Here are our 2026 upcoming Level 3 Mat Pilates cohorts:

Can I upgrade to include Reformer training?

Yes! When you book your Level 3 Mat course, you can add on our Reformer Pilates CPD.

Our Reformer CPD is designed for instructors who already hold a Level 3 Mat qualification.

Do I need to be Level 3 qualified to teach Reformer Pilates?

While there are no national standards mandating Level 3 for Reformer, most employers and insurers expect that you are qualified at Level 3 plus have further Reformer training.

Our Reformer CPD ensures you gain real, hands-on experience, teaching practice, and confidence on the bed.

FAQS

Will I be insured after training?

Yes once you complete your Level 3 Mat Pilates Diploma and practical assessment, you're in a strong position to get insurance. For Reformer, because there are no fixed national standards, your insurer will often require both your Level 3 qualification and proof of hands-on Reformer training, which our CPD provides.

What's required for the Reformer CPD course?

To complete the Reformer CPD:

- You'll attend a 2-day practical training on-site.
- You need to complete coursework beforehand, including logging 30 hours of personal Reformer practice.
- For assessment, you'll design a class plan and teach a 20-minute peer-led Reformer class.

How many people are in each cohort?

Spaces are limited because we keep the group small to ensure hands-on learning, safety, and quality mentoring.

What support will I have during training?

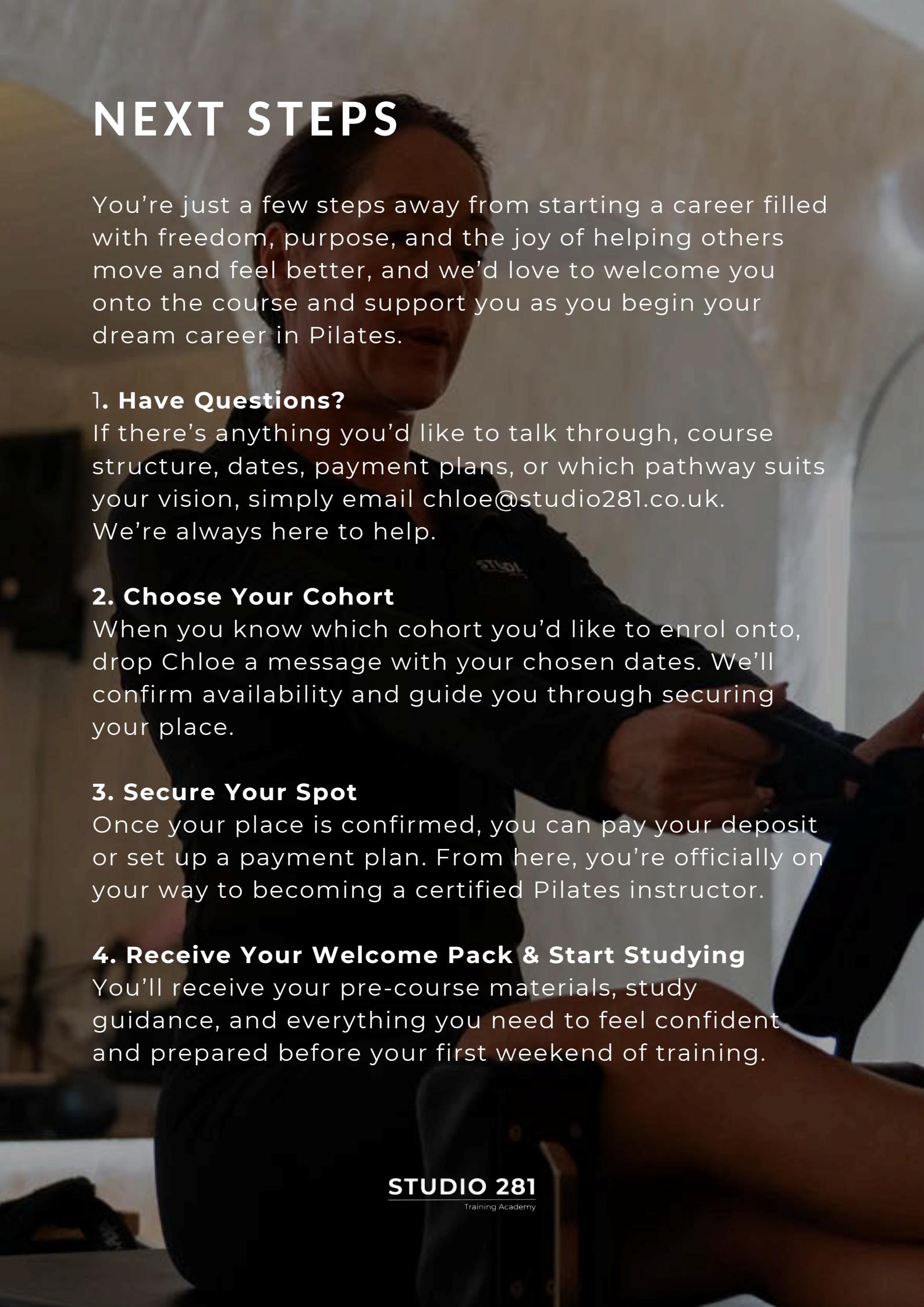
You'll be supported by dedicated Learner Support Tutors for your theory and practical work. We also encourage peer learning, observation, and feedback.

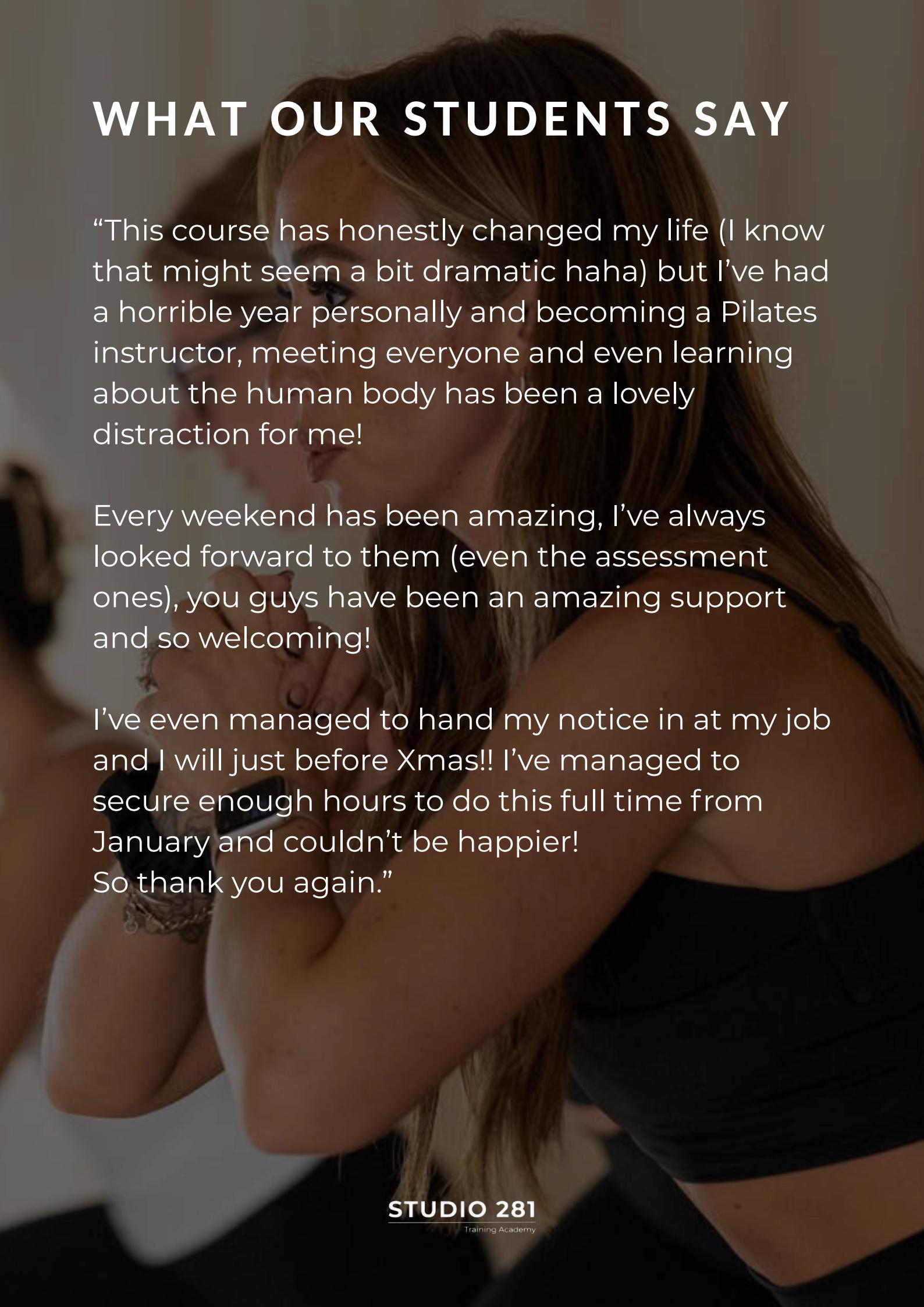

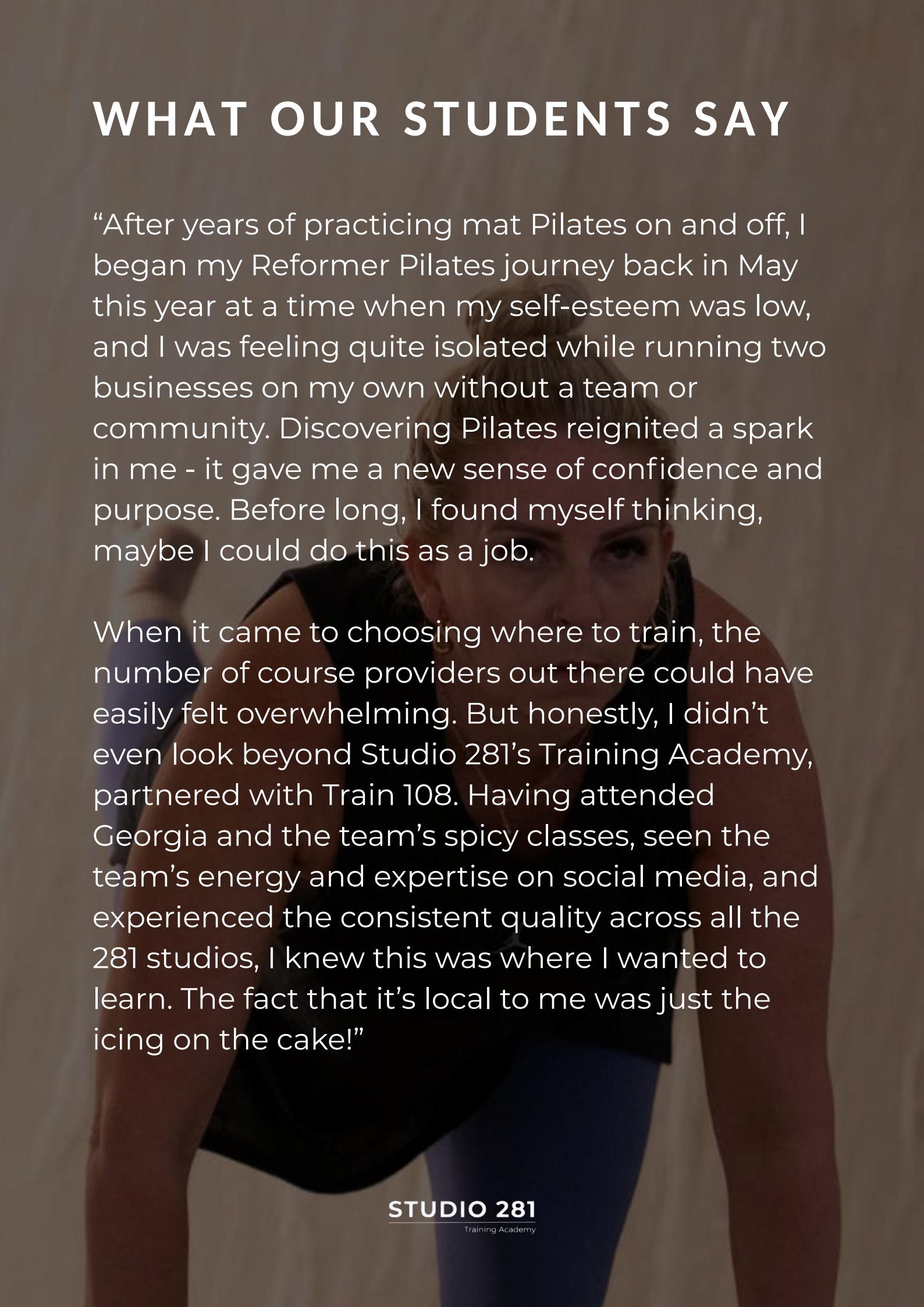

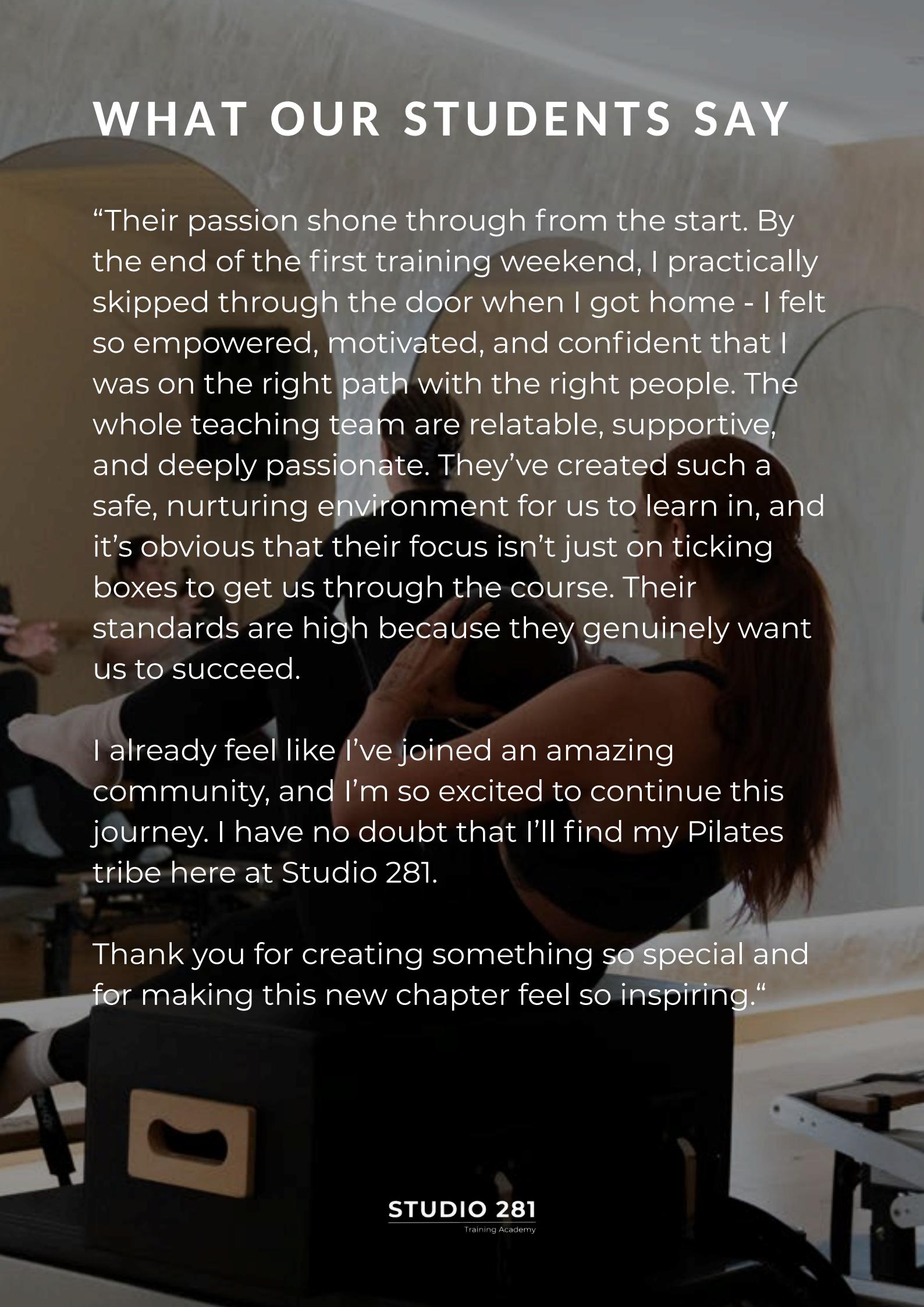
